The Social Guidelines of the University of Louisiana Monce Fraternity and Social Yulife induces the provisions that follow and shall apply to all fraternity and social yentities and all levels of fraternity and social ymembership. The Office of Student Development serves as the University's approving authority.

- 2 Noakcholic beverages may be purchased through an organization is treasury, normaly the purchase of alcoholic beverages formen below or greats be under taken or coordinated by any member in the name of or on behalf of the organization
- 3 Noakohic bewages of bulk quantity or common sources (legs, cases, jurgle juice, etc.) may be puckased, accepted as a donation, or used under any circumstances. Providing a common source of any akcholic bewage-beit beer; a kcholic purch, or an open bar-implies that it is provided by or on behalf of the organization, regardless of who actually puckased it. In addition, no akchol may be served from common source containers on organization property or a togarizational events. This provision also applies to third party versions. 2 Any depters with a form of housing must have emergency numbers for fire, police, and an bulance posted by common phones and in other locations, and should have posted evacuation routes on the back of the door of each sleeping room

3 The possession and/or use of fiteams or explosive devices of any kind within the confines or premises of any chapter house are expressly forbidden

All fires shall be reported to the Goardinator of Greek Life within 24 hours of insident. Failure to do so will result in a sanction
